The lecture will be given in English.

Teacher shortages is a global concern that has dominated the educational policy discourse internationally in recent years. This has prompted some governments to prioritise visas for overseas teachers and encourage immigrants trained as teachers to work in schools. However, the prevailing expectations of specified desired background, habitus and pedagogical ideas of how a teacher should be, act, and understand their work and place in society have made the professional transition significantly more challenging for the immigrant teachers who did not fit into this frame. In this lecture, I will draw on the insights from my research on teacher diversity and immigrant teachers. In particular, I will share the findings of a qualitative study that involves in-depth interviews that explore the professional transition experiences of Asian immigrant teachers in Australia. Findings revealed the differential, diverse and stratified experiences of Asian immigrant teachers as they negotiate their identities, navigate adaptation and establish belongingness in their new teaching context.
