Program Details

HUSTEP is a 'junior year abroad' type program designed to provide undergraduate students from affiliated universities with the opportunity to study in Japan at Hokkaido University. Participants in this program take a wide variety of classes offered in English. For more information, please see the website below.

There is a screening process and not all students who apply will be accepted.

Hokkaido University Short-Term Exchange Program (HUSTEP) – Hokkaido University

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for HUSTEP, students must:

- 1.be enrolled in full-time undergraduate degree programs at overseas universities that have concluded a student exchange agreement with Hokkaido University.
- 2. be enrolled and pay tuition fees at their home universities as full-time students during the entire period of study in Japan.
- 3. have completed at least two years of undergraduate study at their own university prior to arrival in Japan.
- 4. have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
- 5. be proficient in English. Non-native English speakers must have a score of at least TOEFL iBT 79 or IELTS 6.5 (from January 2028 onward, we will employ new TOEFL iBT scoring and the minimum requirement will be 4.5 points).
- 6. be able to arrive by late September or the first week of April.
- *A different internationally-recognized English test result such as CEFR (at least C1) may be accepted.

TOEIC and Duolingo are not accepted.

Application Procedure

- 1. Home University Coordinator provides students with online application link.
- 2. Student completes the forms.
- 3. Home University Coordinator also uploads necessary forms to the application platform and then the student finalizes the online application.
- 4. Hokkaido University reviews the application.
- 5. Hokkaido University notifies successful applicants and issues further instructions.

Required Documents

The application package should include the following documents:

Documents need to be submitted by applicants (students):

- 1) Completed HUSTEP online application (through TAO system)
- 2) Consent to Transfer and Process Personal Data (Everyone)
- 3) Digital ID Photos
- 4) TOEFL, IELTS or CEFR score certificate (non-native English speakers only)
- 5) HU (Hokkaido University) Study Plan
- 6) Certificate of Scholarship/Student Loan (if applicable)

Documents need to be submitted by the home institution's international office:

- 7) Completed Certificate of Enrollment Form
- 8) Recommendation Letter from an academic supervisor
- 9) Official Transcript of academic record
- 10) University Grading System

Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.

Credits

Credits and grades are issued for each semester.
