<b>Program Details</b>	
<p>HUSTEP is a 'junior year abroad' type program designed to provide undergraduate students from affiliated universities with the opportunity to study in Japan at Hokkaido University. Participants in this program take a wide variety of classes offered in English. <b>Eligibility</b>	
<p>To be eligible to apply for HUSTEP, students must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. be enrolled in full-time undergraduate degree programs at overseas universities that have concluded a student exchange agreement with Hokkaido University.</li> <li>2. be enrolled and pay tuition fees at their home universities as full-time students during the entire period of study in Japan.</li> <li>3. have completed at least two years of undergraduate study at their own university prior to arrival in Japan.</li> <li>4. have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.</li> <li>5. be proficient in English. Non-native English speakers must have a score of at least TOEFL iBT 79 or IELTS 6.5 (from January 2028 onward, we will employ new TOEFL iBT scoring and the minimum requirement will be 4.5 points).</li> <li>6. be able to arrive by late September or the first week of April.</li> </ol> <p>*A different internationally-recognized English test result such as CEFR (at least C1) may be accepted. TOEIC and Duolingo are not accepted.</p>	
<b>Application Procedure</b>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Home University Coordinator provides students with online application link.</li> <li>2. Student completes the forms.</li> <li>3. Home University Coordinator also uploads necessary forms to the application platform and then the student finalizes the online application.</li> <li>4. Hokkaido University reviews the application.</li> <li>5. Hokkaido University notifies successful applicants and issues further instructions.</li> </ol>	
<b>Required Documents</b>	
<p>The application package should include the following documents:</p> <p>Documents need to be submitted by applicants (students):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Completed HUSTEP online application (through TAO system)</li> <li>2) Consent to Transfer and Process Personal Data (Everyone)</li> <li>3) Digital ID Photos</li> <li>4) TOEFL, IELTS or CEFR score certificate (non-native English speakers only)</li> <li>5) HU (Hokkaido University) Study Plan</li> <li>6) Certificate of Scholarship/Student Loan (if applicable)</li> </ol> <p>Documents need to be submitted by the home institution's international office:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>7) Completed Certificate of Enrollment Form</li> <li>8) Recommendation Letter from an academic supervisor</li> <li>9) Official Transcript of academic record</li> <li>10) University Grading System</li> </ol> <p>Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.</p>
