Japanese Language and Culture Studies Program (JLCSP) – Hokkaido Universiy

Eligibility

Students who meet the following conditions:

- 1. Undergraduate students
- 2. Majoring in Japanese Language and/or Japanese Culture
- 3. Equivalent to JLPT level N3 or higher
- 4. Enrollment at home university: Exchange students are required to be enrolled at their home university as a full-time student during the entire period of exchange.
- 5. Possessing a good academic record at university level.

Application Procedure

[Embassy Recommendation] (Only for One Year Course)

Procedures are different from each country. Applicants should inquire at the Japanese Embassy in their country.

[Direct application]

- 1. Home University Coordinator provides students with online application link.
- 2. Student completes the form.
- 3. Home University Coordinator also uploads necessary forms to the application platform and then the student finalizes the online application.
- 4. Hokkaido University reviews the documents.
- 5. Hokkaido University notifies successful applicants and issues further instructions.

Required Documents

- Documents need to be submitted by applicants (students):
- 1. Application form for Japanese Language and Culture Studies Program students (through TAO system)
- 2. Content to Transfer and Process Personal Data
- 3. Certificate of passing at least N3 of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (Applicant who have not taken the Japanese Language Proficiency Test must submit a Certificate of Japanese Language Proficiency)
- 4. Digital photo data
- 5. Study plan in Hokkaido University
- Documents need to be submitted by the home institution's international office:
- 6. Certificate of enrollment
- 7. Recommendation Letter
- 8. Official transcript of academic record

Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted.

Credits

The program is a credited program. Students will receive their academic transcripts at the end of the program.

Scholarship

- 1. Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship: Only one year course applicants are eligible to apply. The expected monthly stipend of this scholarship is 117,000 JPY (120,000 JPY for November to March)
- 2. JASSO scholarship: Only half year course applicants are eligible to apply. The monthly stipend of this scholarship is 80,000 JPY.
